Jesus Was A Teacher

Jesus was a teacher. We call our Lord by many names –Messiah, Son of God, Savior, the Great Physician, and the servant of God and humans. But the one name of primary importance is Teacher.

Jesus came forth from a religious tradition that put the greatest importance upon instruction in the faith. The teacher—or rabbi, as he was called—occupied a revered place in Judaism. An instructor of faith and particularly one who undertook the instruction of youth were very serious considerations. The best minds and the most able persons were recruited for the task of teaching.

Jesus was a teacher in the strictest Jewish sense. His vocation, however, was not so much teaching about how to get along in life, but teaching the way of life—what it is all about, what God expects of us, what love requires of us. It was not humankind in general that Jesus taught, but persons in particular—the individual as God’s child.

While Jesus’ teaching was applicable for all, it was always directed to the individual. Jesus taught individuals about life under God’s loving guidance and care. Jesus taught what we are to be, what we are to do, how we are to live and to love under the guidance of God.

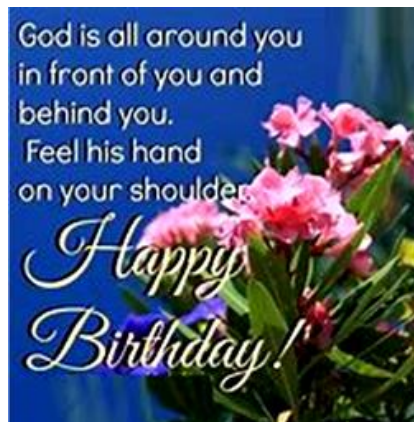
