FROM THE PASTOR

Well, quite literally, the word "Lent" was originally a German word (Actually from an early Germanic tribe call the "Teutons" which were around before there was even a country called Germany.) that meant "spring season". Lent has been used for centuries by Christians to describe the 40-day period that leads up to the Resurrection of Our Lord.

We use the season of Lent, beginning on Ash Wednesday, as an opportunity to consider the suffering and death of Jesus Christ. As part of this meditation, we realize that it was our sin that put Jesus on the cross and His suffering should be our suffering. The death he died should be our death. It's kind of a sobering thought, don't you think?

That's why, although I preach about sin throughout the year, we really emphasize it during Lent. Lent is a season of repentance that culminates in Christ's death...the payment for those very same sins we've been pondering for the last 40 days.

So how do we commemorate it? Well first, we do it solemnly. When you consider that Christ suffered and died in our place, there's nothing else we can do.

We use the season as a time to re-focus ourselves on Christ and the cross. This may mean that we try to create or re-create good spiritual disciplines like prayer, devotion, or study of God's Word. It may mean that we make weekly attendance at Sunday worship services more of a priority in our lives. It may mean that we examine our giving practices and determine if we are indeed giving cheerfully as a response to the gifts God has given us. It may mean that we fast.

Oh... that one hurts! Fasting is something we don't talk about much, but it historically has been one of the identifiable marks of Lent. Martin Luther writes that "Fasting and bodily preparation are certainly fine outward training." Jesus gave his disciples instructions not for *if* they fast, but for *when* they fast. However, remember that fasting is just a tool like any discipline used during Lent, to help you consider anew Christ's sacrifice.

I like to think that when you fast, you're kind of telling your stomach that it doesn't rule your life. If you fast, hunger pains may call to mind the suffering that Christ endured. If you chose to fast, the time you once used for eating might now be replaced with prayer, meditation and devotion...which as I said earlier... is the whole point of the season.

May God richly bless you and your family during this Lenten season no matter how you choose to observe it!
