FROM THE PASTOR

Dear brothers and sisters.

Greetings in the name of our Lord Jesus. Last week was Announcement Sunday and although there were 37 saints in attendance, I know that what was shared that day needs to be shared with everyone in our congregation.

As you may know, each year pastors and churches within the United Methodist tradition arrive at a decision point where they must decide if the current pastor continues to lead the church for another season or if it's time for a change. In some cases, the leadership of the church requests a change... and sometimes the Pastor and his or her family makes the decision. Sometimes it's clear to both parties that a change is needed. Of course, the final decision is made by the Bishop and the Cabinet. This year is a bit different for several reasons.

First and most important, as of July 1, after 21 years of ministry, I will be Officially Retired. This is mandatory in our Denomination for Pastors when they reach the age of 72. I have grown to know and love our family here at Trinity and in many ways, I was not looking forward to leaving, especially with the upcoming choices concerning Denomination as a whole and Trinity in particular.

However, several months ago I was in conference with our District Superintendent and after expressing my concerns with him, Rev. Foshee offered the opportunity to return for one year after retirement. After much prayer and consideration Sharon and I have made the decision to accept the full-time appointment extension for another year.

Another change that you should be made aware of is we have a new Chair of the Administrative Council. As most of you know Tina Mullis is getting remarried and has moved to St. Augustine. Tina submitted her resignation at our last meeting. I have asked Alice Ryals to take Tina's place as Chair. Alice has served that position in the past and I'm sure will do a great job again.

In the 3rd chapter of the book of Ecclesiastes there's a very popular passage. In fact, back in 1965 a group called "The Birds" recorded a Platinum Hit song based on these words. *To everything there is a season, A time for every purpose under heaven:* And then the scripture goes on to list 14 "Seasons". We are all moving into a new season, in our Denomination, in our nation and indeed, in our world. My prayer for each of us is that we remain close to our Lord, for only He has the power and knowledge to get us through the months and years ahead.

May the Lord bless you and keep you in all that you do in His name.
