Forgiveness

³ Then Jesus told them this parable: ⁴ "Suppose one of you has a hundred sheep and loses one of them. Doesn't he leave the ninety-nine in the open country and go after the lost sheep until he finds it? ⁵ And when he finds it, he joyfully puts it on his shoulders ⁶ and goes home. Then he calls his friends and neighbors together and says, 'Rejoice with me; I have found my lost sheep.' ⁷ I tell you that in the same way there will be more rejoicing in heaven over one sinner who repents than over ninety-nine righteous persons who do not need to repent. (NIV, Luke 15:3–7)

We are all sinners in our own ways (<u>Romans 3:23</u>, <u>1 John 1:8</u>), but God is always willing to forgive our sins and give us a new start! First, we must repent (<u>Luke 5:31-32</u>, <u>Luke 24:47</u>, <u>Acts 3:19</u>) and forgive other people who have sinned against us (<u>Matthew 6:14-15</u>, <u>Mark 11:25</u>). Repentance means a sincere resolve to turn away from sin and toward God. True repentance involves sorrow for acts of sin and leads to a fundamental change in attitude.
