FROM THE PASTOR

Dear Church Family,

It seems that there is light at the end of the tunnel. After many on-line conferences with the Bishop, Cabinet and District Superintendent we have a Reopening Date.

However, it does come with many restrictions, some of which would keep many of you from attending live worship. Fortunately, we have been given a couple of choices, one of which should work for us. It's not ideal, but it does allow us to be together to worship again on Sunday morning.

Beginning Sunday morning July 5th, we will be having "Drive in Church". This means that I will be preaching at the end of the Sunday-school wing and everyone will drive their cars to church and park around in the back lot so that you can see me. There will be ushers directing you to your parking spot.

I will be preaching into a special Microphone that will broadcast on an FM frequency that you can dial up on your car radio. You will have a choice of sitting in the cool airconditioned car listening to the service, or you can sit outside. If you sit outside, please bring a folding lawn chair.

There are a few reasons that I decided not to go with a service inside the sanctuary.

- If we had an inside service anyone over the age of 65 or with health issues such as asthma would be encouraged not to attend.
- If we had an inside service everyone would be required to wear a mask.
- If we had an inside service after all the restrictions are met, we would probably only have an attendance of around 10-15 people.
- If we had an inside service, we could not have congregational singing.

On the other hand, having the service outside

- Allows everyone to attend.
- Allows us to have congregational singing.
- No mask required but are highly recommended.

Once again, this is not the ideal, however considering where we have been it's a giant step forward. My deepest concern is for the health and wellbeing of each one of you. I want you to remain safe as we worship our Lord.

E-Giving Coming to Trinity United Methodist Website and Facebook

You have a few other ways to help the work of Trinity UMC Palatka with your financial support in

the coming days. The Administrative Council voted to connect with Vanco Services and provide the ability to pay by credit card, debit card or from your checking/savings account. The software will be on our website trinityumcpalatka.org and our Facebook page facebook.com/tumcpalatka. The implementation will be over the next two weeks and a letter will be sent by e-mail or postal service mail depending on the way you currently receive our newsletter. The cost to the church is between 1% to 2.75% depending on the type of payment method used and \$.45 per transaction. The literature suggests that we can increase our giving by making payment methods available to viewers from outside the church who see our website or Facebook page. Because of the restrictions regarding worship in person, we have seen an increased use of our online resources. Prayerfully the use will be by persons who do not normally attend our services in person and they will be led by the Holy Spirit to contribute to the work of Trinity. The giving service is available to anyone who would like to contribute and we will have the same tracking ability we have with donations made in person or through mailed in contributions. Statements will be provided quarterly to those who donate and we ask for your assistance in letting others know of this new capability. Stay safe, healthy and be wrapped in the blessed arms of Christ.
