All coming together to praise God in song.



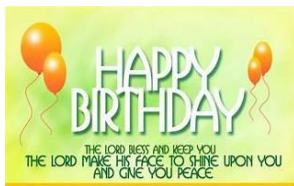
A Lenten challenge from our Lenten calendar to send cards to those who are ill and in our prayers.
